



Spirituality Statement

- *Reflection opportunities through music, prayer and silence
- *Stories from the Bible to help us better understand God's love and how we can join in with the work of his Spirit.

We empower our children to become involved in the planning and leading of collective worship and our Worship Team meets weekly with Mrs Rinaldi and Jess to plan our termly acts of worship for major feasts in the Church year such as Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Easter, Harvest, Remembrance.
