Our Learning

Each learning experience will start with a hook and finish with an end goal. The steps towards our end goal are carefully planned and personalised to enable your child to make good progress. At the end of each learning experience the children will reflect on their learning and then bring their learning journals home to share with you. It would be lovely if you could write a comment on the sheet and return the book back to school the following day. This is a really special way of the children sharing their learning with you and having the opportunity to see their progress!

London!

Our first learning experience this term will be London! The children will learn about how London has changed over the years and the historical and modern buildings. They will be writing their own river cruise commentary after we have been on our exciting trip!



The Three Little Pigs

Our narrative this term will be based on the Three Little Pigs story. The children will be practicing their narrative writing skills by rewriting the story with a twist!

Georgia O'Keeffe

This will be a week long art learning experience where the children will learn all about the artist Georgia O'Keeffe. We will learn about shades, tints and secondary colours which will help us create our own Georgia O'Keeffe inspired art. We will also be writing a description of our artwork as part of our end goa.



What is light?

Our first science learning experience this term will be learning all about light! The children will have the opportunity to carry out lots of different investigations to develop their understanding. After each investigation we will write an explanation which the children will eventually do independently for their end goal.

Apprentice week!


Our design technology learning experience will be the apprentice

Root to Shoot

Our final learning experience of the term will teach the children all about plants. They will learn about the requirements of plants for life and growth, how water is transported and the life cycle of plants. The children will write an informative non-fiction report showing everything that they have learnt.



Reading

Our whole class reading text this term will be Owen and the Soldier by Lisa Thompson.

Please make sure that your child is reading out loud to an adult every day, even if they are a free reader. It is really important that they have the opportunity to develop their expression and comprehension. Please try and talk to your child about what has happened, what might happen next and how characters may be feeling. We are working hard in school to help the children develop their stamina with reading so it would be great if they can be reading for longer periods of time to help this!

Please remember to have labelled PE kit in school every day. Trainers are essential and on cooler days remember to pack a warm jumper! Curtis is working with us on a Thursday and Friday afternoon.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework will continue being set on a Friday and is due in on a Friday. All homework will be stuck into a homework book.
