Our Learning

Each learning experience will start with a hook and finish with an end goal. The steps towards our end goal are carefully planned and personalised to enable your child to make good progress. At the end of most learning experience's the children will reflect on their learning and then they will bring their learning journals home to share with you. It would be lovely if you could write a comment on the sheet and return the book back to school the following day. This is a really special way of the children sharing their learning with you and having the opportunity to see their progress!

The Egyptians!

Our second history learning experience will be The Egyptians. We will hook the children into this learning experience by learning a dance to the song 'Walk like an Egyptian'. The children will learn about lots of different aspects of how the Egyptians lived. For our end goal, the children will write an explanation of the mummification process!



Forces

Our science based learning experience will be learning all about forces and magnets. We will be doing lots of experiments that will help us write our end goals. The children will write instructions and an explanation for one of our experiments.

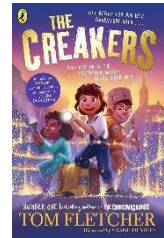
Rivers

Our whole class reading text for this term is The Creakers by Tom Fletcher. The whole class are reading this book. Some children will be working in a smaller group to give more opportunities to read aloud.

Please make sure your child is reading out loud to an adult every day at home. It's really effective when you ask the children about what they have read to help improve their comprehension skills too!
