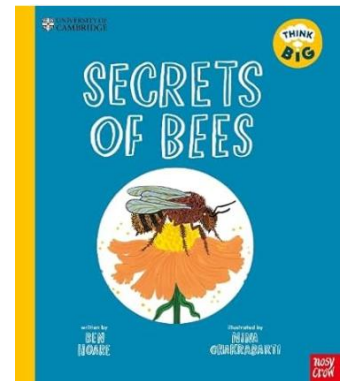

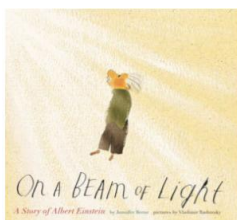
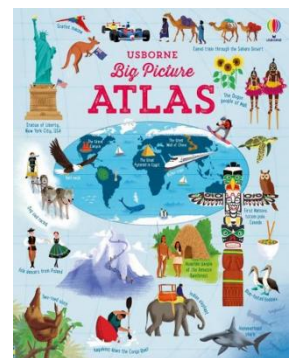


Perfect Pizzas!
