Today, why not start your day with a quick jog around the garden/playground! It's cold, very, cold, so you'll have to run quickly!

Let's get started!
Today, watch again yesterday's reading video and select 3 more questions. Challenge yourself today! Try different reading skills. If you chose vocabulary and predictions questions yesterday, why not try explain and retrieve today.

Start to 'It was a huge bushy tail'.	
Vocabulary	What does it mean when we say 'something funny' happened to someone? What does it mean if you 'see red'?
Infer	Why do you think the girl hates hunting? How can you tell the boys didn't take the narrator seriously? What happened to Mrs Winter when the magic finger was put on her? Why did the children scream with laughter?
Predict	Predict what 'putting the magic finger' on somebody means.
Explain	Why do you think the author chose to include illustrations of the family? Do you think Mrs Winter deserved what happened to her? Why?
Retrieve	Who owns the farm? What are their children called? How old is the narrator? What do the Gregg family love to do? What had Mrs Winter asked the girl to do?
Summarise	Sum the girl up so far by choosing one word to describe her and explaining your choice of word.

Be sure to take a break before you start your writing challenge today.

Today is step 2 of our writing journey. Our focus is on the use of imperative verbs which we will need to use in our final piece of writing.



You questions to choose from are on Seesaw. Remember to select 3 from different reading areas.

I cannot begin! to 'So they went to bed and went to sleep'	
Vocabulary	What is a 'forefinger'? What does it mean if someone is 'taking for it'? What does it mean if a duck is wild, in the context of these pages?
Infer	Why won't Mrs Winter be alright again? When does the magic finger happen? Why did they think the four ducks would be easy to hit? Why did Mr Gregg go red in the face? Why do you think Mr Gregg was afraid?
Predict	Predict what the magic finger will do to the Greggs.
Explain	Why do you think the author capitalised 'BANG'?
Retrieve	What animals were the Greggs off to hunt? How many birds did they get in the first hour? How many in the second hour? Why did Mr Gregg go outside in the night?
Summarise	Summarise what has happened to the Greggs so far in one sentence.

Today our learning focus is going to be on Multiply 2-digits by 1-digit - no exchange


