


Today you will select 4 questions to answer, two from Vocabulary and 2 from Infer. These questions are on Seesaw. We will talk about them in our lesson.







Fabric Dyeing





A Neolithic grave at Pentre Ifan, Wales. When it was built, the stones would have been covered by a large mound of earth.

Stone Age people could not pop to the shop for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your own recipe for a stone age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them.

Or, try making this recipe!

STONE AGE Stewed Fruit Recipe 30 mins

You will need...
50g blueberries
50g blackberries
20g hazelnuts
4 tbsp honeycomb

Ingredients: Blueberries, Blackberries, Hazelnuts, Honeycomb

1. Add the blueberries to the pan.
2. Add the blackberries to the blueberries. Using a wooden spoon mix them together - make sure you do this gently so you don't crush the fruit.
3. Add the hazelnuts and carefully mix it all together.
4. Add the honeycomb and transfer the pan to the stove (you might need to ask an adult for help with this. Bring the mixture gently to the boil).
5. Simmer the mixture very carefully for 20mins. Leave to cool then transfer to a serving bowl.




